Speaker Shekarchi to announce 2024 housing legislation

STATE HOUSE – House Speaker K. Joseph Shekarchi will continue his efforts to address Rhode Island's housing crisis with his fourth package of legislation pertaining to housing, which he will unveil during a news conference on Thursday.

The news conference will be held **Thursday**, **March 7**, **at 3:15 p.m. in the House Lounge** on the second floor of the State House.

Shekarchi has announced a comprehensive suite of housing legislation each year since becoming Speaker in 2021; his 2024 efforts build upon the initiatives outlined in his previous legislative parcels.

Speaker Shekarchi (D-Dist. 23, Warwick) will be joined by Rhode Island Secretary of Housing Stefan Pryor; Rep. June S. Speakman, chair of the Special Legislative Commission to Study Housing Affordability; Thomas E. Deller, chair of the Special Legislative Commission to Study Land Use; members of both commissions; legislators; housing and homelessness advocates; builders; and developers.

The news conference will be televised live on Capitol Television, which can be seen on Cox channel 61, on i3Broadband channel 15 and on Verizon channel 34.
